### Prayer for the whole world:

- SAMARITAN'S PURSE aid workers in South Sudan, as armed rebels are holding eight employees hostage. The kidnappers are demanding food as ransom;
- COMPASSION INTERNATIONAL in India: the government has denied them the ability to transfer funds into the country. Operations are about to cease, 145,000 Indian children will be without aid, and 589 Indian-staffed centers will be closed;
