In 2015, a substantial bequest by beloved former member, Robert Morrison, enabled the Park Street Missions Committee to grant awards to several missions initiatives. One of them was Upward Stars Boston, a program that promotes the discovery of Jesus through sport. What started in December as a basketball skills clinic with three kids at the Kroc Center in Dorchester has now grown to nearly 50, and continues to expand rapidly. Our kids range from 9-16 years of age. The majority come from neighborhoods with some of the toughest gang and drug activity in Dorchester, Roxbury and Matta-

pan. We offer tutoring services at the Kroc Center twice a week while mentoring kids on and off the court. Our coaches model Christ and share the gospel through weekly character lessons designed to illustrate how the gospel applies to their lives. We are looking to add Christian leaders who are called to inner city youth ministry to help build a culture where young people can openly and readily identify themselves as Christians, and shine the light of Christ to their neighbors. 
