Pre-Service Hymns

Each week from now through JUN 5, join Nathan Skinner, Director of Music, in singing requested favorites before the service.

HYMN NOTE

Ralph Vaughan Williams intended his tune to be paired with "For All the Saints," and it has been regarded by many as the finest ever composed. The melody is named *Sine Nomine* which means "without a name," as a reminder that the hymn is about all the saints who have died in Christ, not merely those noteworthy believers traditionally referred to with the title (e.g. St. Paul, St. Augustine). In fact, in the first stanza, the hymn explicitly defines the scope: the saints are all those "who Thee, by faith, before the world confessed." See Rom. 10:9, 1 Tim. 6:12, Heb. 11:1, 1 John 4:15.

An analysis of the text with numerous scripture references for every stanza is available at 'the www.congsing.org/for_all_the_saints.html.

These stanzas do not appear in our hymnal, but were part of William How's original:

For the apostles' glorious company (who, bearing forth the cross o'er land and sea, shook all the mighty world) we sing to thee: Alleluia, Alleluia!

For the Evangelists,† (by whose blest word, like fourfold streams, the garden of the Lord is fair and fruitful) be thy name adored.

Alleluia, Alleluia!

For martyrs (who with rapture-kindled eye, saw the bright crown descending from the sky, and seeing, grasped it) thee we glorify.

Alleluia. Alleluia!

O blest communion, fellowship divine! We feebly struggle, they in glory shine; yet all are one in thee, for all are thine. Alleluia. Alleluia!

And when the strife is fierce, the warfare long, Steals on the ear the distant triumph song, And hearts are brave, again, and arms are strong. Alleluia, Alleluia!
