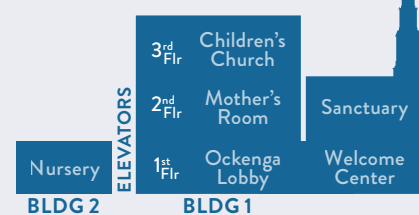

It is especially fitting to sing of the Holy Spirit in connection with the proclamation and preaching of scripture. 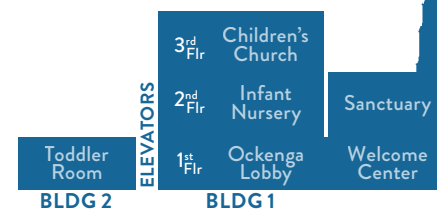
