



### HYMN NOTE

O Word of God Incarnate

In this hymn, the singer is addressing Jesus Christ, who is called upon with the four phrases starting with "O." Jesus is the incarnate Word of God (John 1), incarnate Wisdom (1 Cor. 1), incarnate Truth (John 14), and incarnate Light (John 8). It is in this context that the hymn then explains how the written word (through wisdom, truth, and light) points us to the living Word, Jesus Christ. In the last stanza we pray that we would faithfully reflect the Light into the world. "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden" (Matt. 5).




