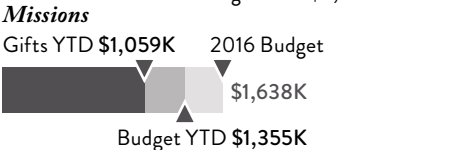
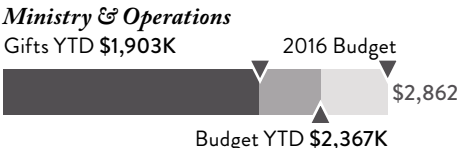

MICHAEL YOUNG-SUK OH is the Executive Director/CEO of the Lausanne Committee for World Evangelization. Dr. Oh received a B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania, an M.Div. from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and an M.A. from Harvard University.

Dr. Oh and his wife, Pearl, served as missionaries with Mission to the World in Nagoya, Japan and founded Christ Bible Institute (CBI) Japan. He has spoken at conferences, churches, and schools around the world including Urbana 2009, Desiring God 2009/2011, and the 2006 Lausanne Younger Leaders Gathering in Port Dixon, Malaysia. Dr. Oh joined the Lausanne Board in 2007 with a particular focus on developing younger leaders within the Lausanne movement.
