Our ministry is a platform for people across the social strata to fellowship by breaking of bread and forming meaningful, Christ-centered community. The five service pillars of the ministry are: 1) health and mental wellbeing of those who have fallen through the cracks; 2) permanent and temporary housing for the disenfranchised; 3) gainful employment; 4) healing through the arts and fellowship; 5) the Servant Leadership Incubator

How we do it:

A team of volunteers gather each week to prepare a meal and offer provisions to serve to our neighbors. We then care for volunteers with time of bible study and fellowship, conditioning our spirit, heart and minds to serve our Lord by serving each other and our neighbors.
