### THURSDAY NIGHT OUTREACH

#### What we do:

Thursday Night Outreach (TNO) exists to address human suffering in our community through practical acts of mercy and compassion. Our ministry is a platform for people across the social strata to fellowship by breaking of bread and forming meaningful, Christ-centered community. The five service pillars of the ministry are: 1) health and mental wellbeing of those who have fallen through the cracks; 2) permanent and temporary housing for the disenfranchised; 3) gainful employment; 4) healing through the arts and fellowship; 5) the Servant Leadership Incubator

#### How we do it:

A team of volunteers gather each week to prepare a meal and offer provisions to serve to our neighbors. We then care for volunteers with time of bible study and fellowship, conditioning our spirit, heart and minds to serve our Lord by serving each other and our neighbors.

#### Why we do it:

The foundations of the ministry are based on Micah 6:8; Isaiah 58; 1 John 3:16-17; James

2:15-16 and the life and directive of Christ.

We believe that acts of mercy advance the Gospel, when done through a Christ-centered approach with a spirit of excellence.

#### When:

Thursday nights, 5:30-9:30 PM. Everyone is welcome to come and leave as their time permits!

#### Where:

Fellowship Hall of the church, Boston Common (by the Brewer Fountain near the T stop), and the area around Tremont and Washington streets.

#### How to pray for TNO:

- 1) For the Lord's wisdom that will result in innovations,
- 2) for favor with decision makers, and the community,
- 3) for an awakening to justice and mercy in the city, state and nation.

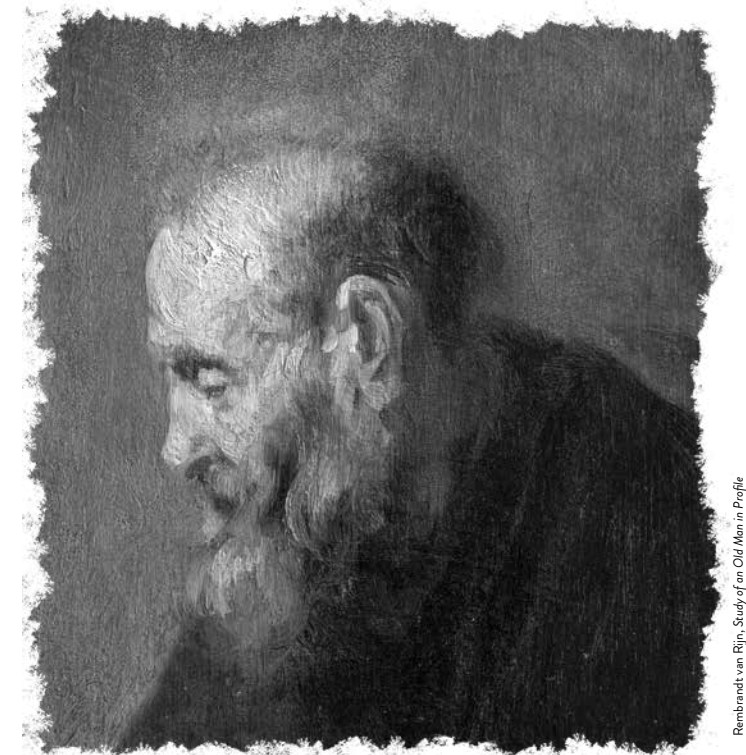

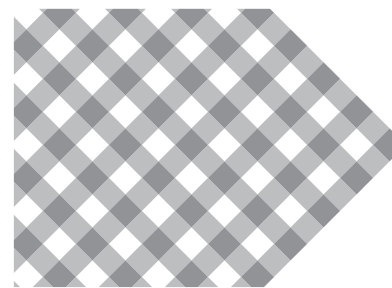
