Dr. Ku’uipolani Kanahale Wong was born and raised on the island of Ni’ihau and is the Graduate Chair and an Associate Professor of the Kawaihuelani Center for Hawaiian Language. She is also the coordinator for the Mānaleo (Native Speaker) Program. She holds her doctorate degree of Philosophy of Education in Curriculum Studies from the University of Hawaii at Mānoa.



Kahu (Senior Pastor) Kenneth Makuakāne was born and raised in Hilo, Hawaii. After graduating from Kamehameha Schools Kapālama campus, he attended the University of Hawaii at Hilo. Following an accomplished music career, in 2010, Kahu Makuakāne answered the call to authorized ministry and began working at the Hawaii Conference of the United Church of Christ, first as an Associate for Church Vitality, and ending his tenure as an Associate Conference Minister and the Papa Makua (the head minister) for the Association of Hawaiian Evangelical Churches. He currently serves at Senior Pastor at Kawaiaha’o Church.
