
## Hosanna, Loud Hosanna

Like a folk song, this tune has been changed over time. Its first iteration, published in 1784, is almost unrecognizable. But when it was published under the auspices of *Hymns Ancient & Modern*, it was fixed for all time. *Hymns A&M* (the first hymnal to be used widely across a whole nation) was first published in 1861, sold 4.5 million copies in the first eight years, and has been highly influential since that time. A great many texts, tunes, and their pairings come from that publication, including *Holy, Holy Holy; Eternal Father, Strong to Save;* and *Crown Him with Many Crowns.*
