
Communities of Missional Practice Overview

Overview

Welcome to this Community of Practice (COP). You may have heard about COPs in your profession or workplace. A simple definition of a COP is: a group of people who share a concern or a passion for something they do and choose to learn how to do it better through regular interaction. A COP has three components - a domain, a community and a set of practices. The image below helps to describe this community of practice.



A community of missional practice, then, can be defined as:

"a group of people who share a passion for the mission of God and choose to learn how to **do it** better through regular interaction"

The Community of Missional Practice environment will be composed of the following:

- a group who are or will become a community of friends.
- a Companion Guide that will provide the theological content for each session, a discussion guide and tools to accompany the practices we are learning.
- a 35 minute learning video where experts in the field will discuss their own biblical and experienced understanding of our subject matter.
- three practices that you will develop and use together.
- a texting environment where you can stay in touch throughout the week.
- resources that you may choose to use to enrich your journey.


The Purpose
