The People read or sing all **bold text** with a loud voice. Where hymns are listed, the name of the tune appears right-flush in small caps. Scripture lessons are taken from the English Standard Version.*

*On the Day of Pentecost (fifty days after Easter), God sent his Holy Spirit to dwell with his people. Many Christians consider this the birthday of the Church, because it both enabled and inaugurated the apostles' mission to proclaim the Gospel of God to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8). The color red is used on Pentecost to signify the fire of the Holy Spirit.*
