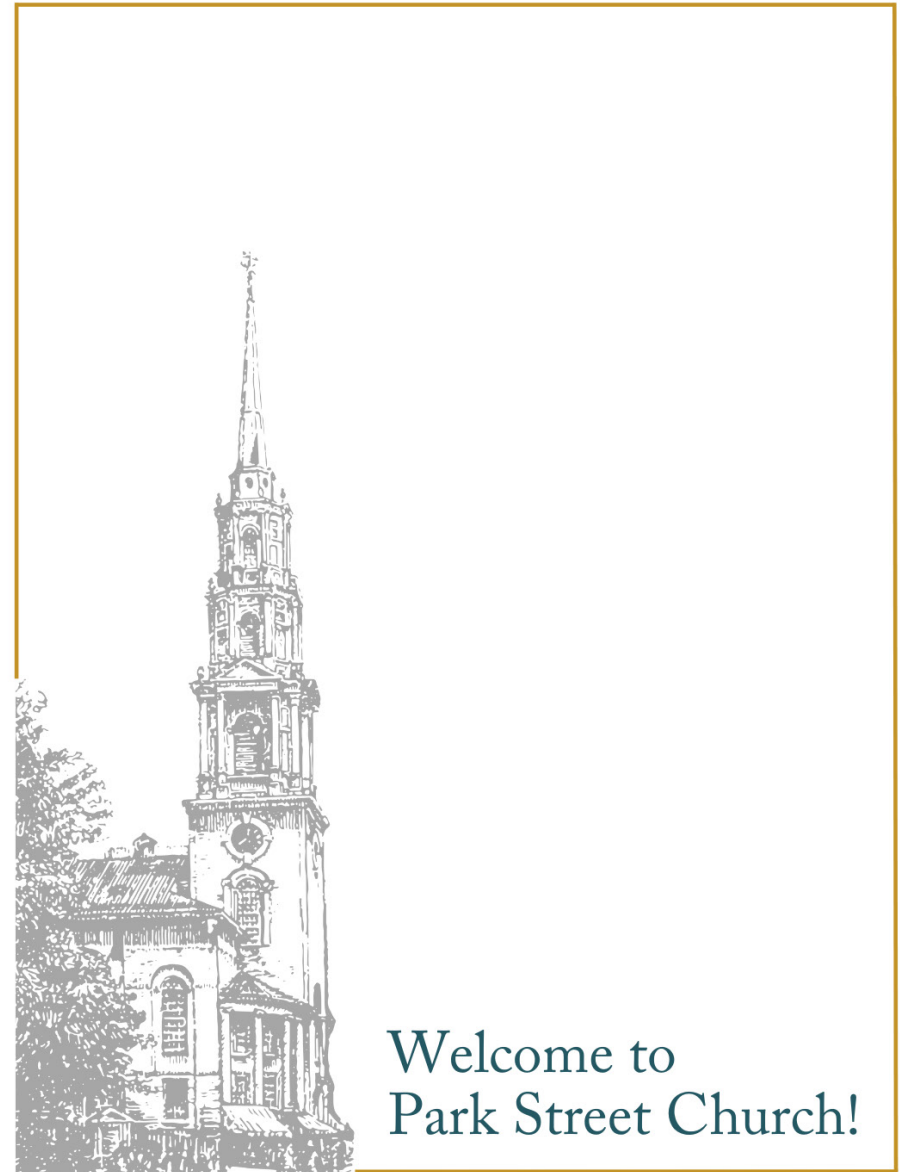
Professional Communications Workshop | Fridays through Dec 8 | 7:00-9:00 pm | *Zoom*
