World Relief 80th Anniversary: Looking Back and Looking Forward

The following announcement appeared in the bulletin on September 24, 1944:

N. A. E. War Relief Campaign. At the suggestion of Dr. Ockenga the N. A. E. has launched a great nation-wide campaign for clothing and money to aid the stricken peoples of Europe before the colds of winter come. All of us have clothing which we do not use but which is usable. Next week we will announce the plan of this church's participation. All money and material collected by N. A. E. will be distributed through Evangelical Christian organizations, thus enhancing the influence of the Gospel by humanitarian work. Examine your closets, cedar chests, and attics this week.

As you fast during Lent, please consider this prayer ______request from World Relief:

Pray for World Relief Kenya as the country faces one of the most severe drought crises in modern African history, disproportionately impacting the historically marginalized region of Turkana.

The crisis is compounded by the fact that 80% of Kenya's population of 47 million live in rural areas, with most dependent on subsistence agriculture. Since the start of the drought, child malnutrition in Turkana has risen from 14% to 30%, while 60-80% of livestock have died from thirst and starvation.
