College Students: Dinner Invitation

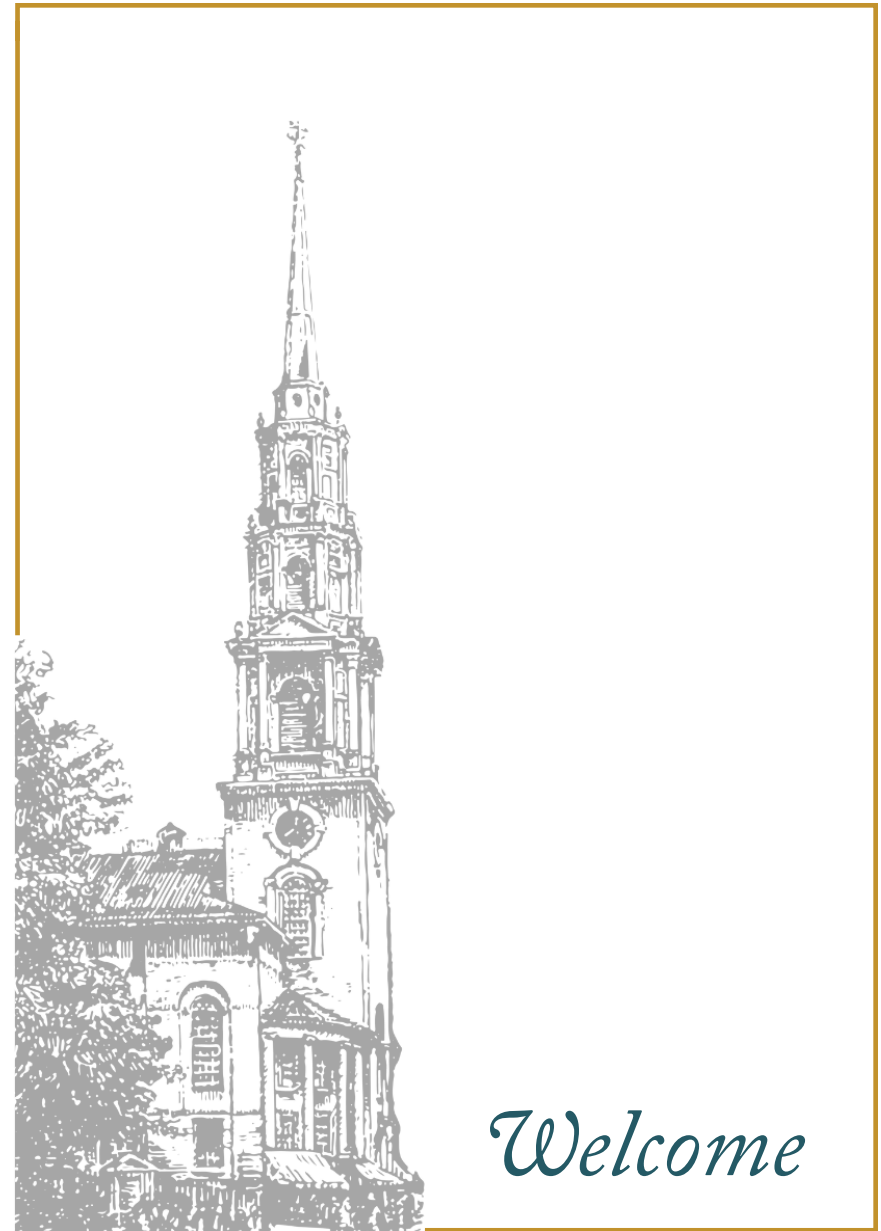
