June 1 Financial Update

Ministry & Operations (M&O):

Through June 1, contribution income was \$831K versus \$1.11M budgeted for the year, a \$283K (25%) shortfall. Giving is 16% below 2024 levels and approximately 15% below the same time in 2023.

Missions:

Through June 1, contribution income was \$515K versus \$619K budgeted, a \$104K (17%) shortfall. Giving is 18% below 2024 levels and approximately 6% below the same time in 2023.
