College Summer Bible Study | Fri, Jul-Aug | *Wilson House*

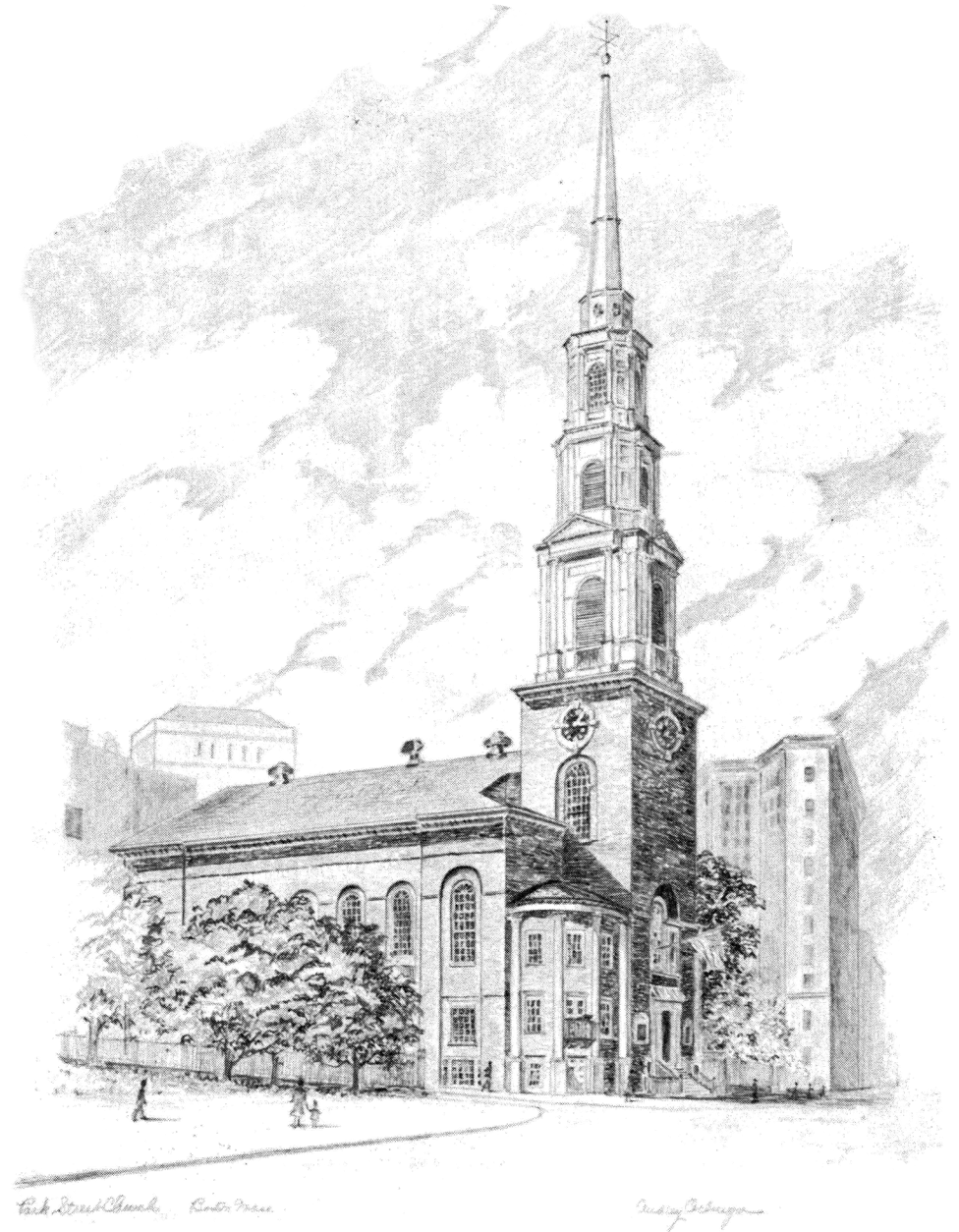
