

DID YOU KNOW...?

The theme for the Global Mission Conference 2025 is "Looking Back, Moving Forward," and as we approach the conference, we would like to share some interesting facts each week from our two hundred-year history of missions at Park Street Church...

Eleanor Wilson, our missionary to the Marshall Islands from 1937 to 1960, depended on water transport to visit the far-flung islands of her parish. This included at least one ship with the moniker *Morning Star*; ships bearing that name were in use by missionaries in the South Pacific beginning in 1856, when the first one sailed out of Boston Harbor. By 1956, another ship was needed to replace the aging *Morning Star VI*, and a candidate was found in Okinawa. Henry van Baay—a long-time member of Park Street Church and a yacht builder from Marblehead—flew to Japan to make it ready for Eleanor's use. How gracious is God to have used the Wilson family and Henry van Baay both in their missionary service and later in their generosity. (The Wilsons donated their home in Cambridge, which we use as a base of operations for college ministry and to house students; the carriage house on the property was later rebuilt with funds given by Henry van Baay into a secondary residence to provide housing for international students.)
